I. questions and Answers

Question 1

On page 7 of the APS 3.2. This APS focuses on basic education activities that may be linked to workforce development and orphans and vulnerable children. Potential applicants must be local organizations registered in Angola. Does this mean: 1) organizations that are already locally resident, which also incorporates international organizations, registered in Angola; 2) or is this just referring to local Angolan NGOs

Answer 1.

Section 3.2 states: "This APS focuses on basic education activities that may be linked to workforce development and orphans and vulnerable children. Potential applicants must be local organizations registered in Angola".

The purpose of this section is to develop Angolan capacity. Therefore, only those organizations that are owned and managed locally in Angola meet this requirement (in addition to the registration requirement).
