## 2. Corrected Q & A's

The following changes are hereby made:

- I. Under – Amendment 01 DGP – RFA 4-8-2011; Question 80; delete the response in its entirety and replace with the following in lieu thereof:

Q: RDMA is listed as a participating mission but in Question 80 on Micronesia you note that RDMA is not participating? My organization planned to submit a proposal for Micronesia to RDMA so this is conflicting information as RDMA is listed on the table and in the participating mission information. Please confirm that a US PVO can submit a proposal to RDMA for work in Micronesia.

**A: “The Regional Development Mission for Asia covers USAID supported activities in the Federated States of Micronesia and because Micronesia is not targeted by RDMA in the RFA this year, organizations seeking support for work in the FSM may not apply. Please check back after October 1, 2011 to see if they are participating in the FY 2012 DGP cycle.”**

## 3. Additional Q&As

- I. Q: The RFA reads, “Applicants may upload applications to [www.grants.gov](http://www.grants.gov)”. From our point of view, it is not clear if this is optional or mandatory. In other words; the application has to be uploaded using the Application package or it is just an option? In case it is optional, all the SF 424 forms (Application for Federal Assistance and Sections A, B, C, D, E) have to be filled in and sent anyway? Or it is possible to send the budget just following the concept paper instructions in point 4: Budget: Proposed budget and timeline?

**A: All federal grant applications are to be submitted via Grants.gov so they can be tracked centrally, but we understand the challenges that applicants from other countries may have in navigating the system. Please try to submit the information using Grants.gov. All other submissions requirements provided in Sections 4 and 5 or the RFA must be met.**

- II. Q: What we have not been able to figure out is whether the funds are available to registered CBO's (community based organizations) or are limited to official NGOs.

**A: The Development Grants Program is only open to those organizations that are registered as an NGO in the country they wish to work in. Please refer to Section 3: “Eligibility Information” for Local NGO requirements.**

- III. Q: Somali Agriculture Technical Group (SATG) is an NGO based in Somalia and would like to apply the DGP mentioned above. Please advise if Somalia is eligible to submit application.

**A: Yes. The East Africa Regional Mission (which covers Somalia) is a participating Mission.**

**IV.** Q: Regarding the Cost Share Component, the RFA states “Funds received by the Applicant directly from the U.S. Government or USAID intermediaries or foreign governments are not allowable elements of the match”. It is not clear on what is meant by foreign governments, whether it refers to other OECD donors or something else altogether.

**A: For the purpose of this RFA a Foreign Government will be considered a governmental entity at any level (local, municipal, province, and sovereign entity, etc...) Public International Organizations are given the same standing as foreign government.**
