Industry Questions #1 - #4 and Government Response

1. In the Funding Opportunity Number – it states under General Requirements – 4.2 Supplies and Equipment that “Recipient shall provide – and it lists many items that would be needed to perform this work. Are those items that the recipient should already possess and would not be allowed to be included in the budget?

Government response:

4.2 supplies and equipment- These are items that the recipient is expected to include in their budget proposal.

2. Are rental and shipping charges allowable expenses?

Government response:

As stated in Funding Opportunity Announcement W911KB-25-2-0010, Section V, allowable costs incurred by States, local governments, Indian tribes, non-governmental organizations, and individuals are determined in accordance with the provision of Cost Principles of 2 CFR 200. OMB's cost principles are contained in 2 CFR 200.400-.475 et seq.

3. The Funding Opportunity Number mentions required attendance of an ITAM Workshop every year. For budgeting purposes where will this workshop be located and an estimate of the number of days required to attend??

Government response:

The ITAM Workshop is located in the contiguous U.S. at an Army installation which changes from year to year. Expected duration is a five-day work week with Monday and Friday as travel dates.

4. Eligible applicants – Business Type Business or Organization, Non-Profit

Government response:

Non-profits are eligible to apply for the subject opportunity.
