Course Description:

This session is highly recommended for federally recognized Tribes interested in applying for Law Enforcement, Occupant Protection, and/or Highway Safety Specialist grants for Fiscal Year 2027 (FY27). Participants will receive comprehensive guidance on federal regulations and grant application requirements, including:

- Completing the grant application
- Developing a problem identification statement
- Crafting effective strategies
- Compiling required traffic safety statistics
- Understanding submission deadlines and procedures

This session is designed to support Tribes in preparing competitive applications for Indian Highway Safety grants.

Eligibility:

This grant opportunity is exclusively available to tribal employees who work for federally recognized tribes who engage in traffic safety-related work.

Funding Coverage:

Grant awards will cover travel expenses and conference registration fees for tribal employees working in the field of traffic safety.

- Grant applications will be available on Grants.gov January 6, 2026
- Application Deadline to apply for Lifesavers Conference Grant is **March 10, 2026**
- All other grant application deadlines are **May 1** of the current fiscal year.
